**FAST FOR HOPE**

On March 9th, the Stillwater Noon Rotary Club will be holding our annual "Fast for Hope" (FFH) recognition. Fast for Hope aims to achieve three things: Raise Rotarian's awareness of the World beyond our borders; raise money while "rewarding" Rotarian with the experience, however briefly, of deprivation endured by most of the world's population; and to perform one BIG project to make a difference in the state of humanity somewhere in the world.

Over the years, our district has raised significant sums of money for this effort. Our current emphasis for FFH is on water projects. Why?

Because research indicates that contaminated water is the main cause of diseases resulting in premature death. The inability of communities to manage water and sanitation systems and practice safe personal hygiene contributes significantly to these problems. On March 9th, instead of the filling and delightful meal that we are used to being

served by the Lowell Inn, we will be having bread and soup (one step up from Bread and water!). The difference in cost between our normal meal and this scaled down meal will be donated to the FFH water project.
