Speaker's Name: Cathy Mackiewicz

Organization: Washington County Department of Public Health and Environment

Cathy gave an overview of the Minnesota student Survey in which 88% of statewide school districts participate. The Survey have been administered every 3 years since 1989. It is given to grades 6, 9 and 12. The survey is voluntary and responses are kept confidential.

The survey student provides state and county level data and reveals trends over time. The survey is intended to examine multiple youth issues, help monitor the effectiveness of prevention efforts, and assist educators, parents and communities to respond to youth needs.

Two highlights among the thirty slides shown are:

Overall Washington County 6th graders chose healthier responses than Minnesota 6th graders.

Responses from Washington County 9th and 12th graders are very similar to Minnesota 9th and 12th grades.
